CIRCUIT SHOW INFORMATION

RULES AND REGULATIONS

All exhibitors are required to thoroughly acquaint themselves with all deferral and state laws governing horses and horse shows. This show is conducted in the spirit of USEF rules. FSHPP academy rules will be followed. This show counts for FSHPP. In the event a rule needs to be clarified, the show manager will act as steward.

Performance exhibitors essentially get two shows in one, showing for different judges on each day.

ENTRIES

Entries close January 31, 2022. Entries must be made on the show's entry form. One horse per entry form. The complete name and address of the registered owner must appear on the entry form. Entries should be emailed to FloridaHorseShowCircuit@gmail.com. Payments may include an open check or a check for all fees.

ARRIVAL INFORMATION

Setup can begin on February 4, 2022. Stalls are available after 10:00am on February 4, 2022. Stalls must be empty by end of day February 6, 2022.

FEES

Stalls \$60 per stall for one day

\$150 per stall for three days (February 4-6, 2022)

Classes \$40 per qualified/academy class

\$50 per stake class

Office Fee \$30 per horse (Academy horses only charged once per horse)

Shavings \$9.50 per bag

Late Entry \$15 per rider after January 31, 2022

REFUND POLICY

Refund requests received prior to February 2, 2022 will be made in full, excluding the office fee per horse.

HEALTH CERTIFICATES AND COGGINS TEST

State law mandates that each exhibitor be in possession of a negative Coggins test conducted within the past 12 months on each horse at the show. All out of state horses must possess a health certificate with temperature recording issued by a veterinarian within 30 days of the show. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to be familiar with rules regarding horses in the state of Florida.

SHOW RING

All entries are advised to be in the warmup area prior to their class. The gate to the show ring will be closed two minutes after the first entrant enters the ring. The show ring will be closed one hour prior to each session.

MISCELLANEOUS

The Florida Horse Show Circuit reserves the right to decline an exhibitor and/or exhibitor's horse before the show, or order away from the premises, without being held liable for damages of any kind. This shall be accepted as a condition of entry and all fees paid shall be forfeit.

Neither the Florida Horse Show Circuit, its management, sponsors, employees, volunteers, or independent contractors will be responsible for any article of any kind or nature that is lost, damaged, destroyed, or stolen, nor liable for any injury sustained to horses, exhibitors, spectators, sponsors, employees, volunteers, or independent contractors.

SPECTATOR AND PET INFORMATION

Please demonstrate good sportsmanship by being respectful of all exhibitors in and out of the show ring. This includes refrain from inappropriate noises or gestures while riders are in the ring. Dogs are allowed but must be on a leash at all times.

ACADEMY RULES AND REGULATIONS

The academy division is for those riders who have never competed in an "A" circuit show. Helmets are required for all riders, in compliance with the 2009 congressional helmet law.

Age and Division Membership to the Florida State High Point Program is required for all riders wanting to compete in the Academy classes. A rider's age for the competition year is determined by the dates of the Ocala International Horse Show.

Class Rules:

Headers are allowed in for safety. No towels or whips. Classes will be split at the 13th rider. Splits will be shuffled to keep showmanship and equitation back-to-back. Class holds will be 2 minutes in length with no exceptions. Holds must be requested 15 minutes before the academy session/show begins. Gate times will be strictly enforced and as one class exits the next will be promptly called.

Academy Horses must be a lesson horse regularly used in a professional operated lesson program. The horse must display safety characteristics accordingly. Horses will be excused from the competition for unsafe behavior, such as going too fast for a rider to handle. Horses are not to be judged and must be serviceably sound. No farm/barn affiliation should be visible on the horse, tack, or rider.

Turn out rules:

A plain shod horse with 1 therapeutic pad is allowed. No braids or artificial appliances are to be used. Hoof blacking and braiding are optional.

Saddle Seat Tack:

Horses may be shown in a snaffle bridle with running martingale or German martingale, Pelham, or double bridle. Saddles must be cutback English saddle. No tie downs, standing martingales, or blinkers allowed. For attire, jodhpurs, jodhpur boots or paddock boots, long sleeved button-down or collared shirts, ties, and gloves are required. Vests are optional, no derbies allowed. Riding whip and non-roweled spurs are optional. Long hair must be secured back in a bun or braid(s).

Hunt Seat Tack:

Horses may be shown in a snaffle bridle with or without a running martingale or German martingale. Pelham or double bridles are allowed. Saddles must be hunt seat saddles. No tie downs or blinkers allowed, standing martingales for over fences classes are permitted. For attire, breeches, an appropriate hunt seat shirt, hunt boots, paddock boots or black hap chaps with black paddock boots, and gloves are required. Riding crop and non-roweled spurs are optional. Long hair must be secured back in bun or braid(s).

Western Tack:

Horses may be shown in a snaffle bridle with or without a running martingale with two hands or a single curb bit bridle with one hand. Saddles must be western saddles. No tie downs, standing martingales, or blinkers allowed. For attire, jeans or pants, a western style Shirt, jodhpur, paddock or western boots, and gloves are required. Chaps and western hats are not allowed. "Polo" shirts are not allowed. Whips and non-roweled spurs are optional. Long hair must be secured back in bun or braid(s).

Driving Tack:

Any 2-wheeled vehicle is allowed. Any work or show harness and cart may be used as long as it is in good working condition. Any academy attire is appropriate, or you may wear pleasure driving attire. Glasses or goggles and gloves are required. Driving whip is optional. Instructor may ride along with the driver, however no instruction can be given.

Academy Equitation:

Judged on the rider's basic equitation skills with correct diagonals and leads. Proper use of the ring is considered.

Academy Showmanship:

Judged on the rider's horsemanship abilities. It is judged on the rider's ability to control and show their horse. The rider's command of the horse, for example, speed, collectiveness and placement in the ring is to be considered. Walk/Trot riders should not be penalized for incorrect diagonals. For walk/trot riders, promptness in finding the correct leads and diagonals is important.

Walk/Trot On the Line Class:

Walk/Trot riders will enter the ring at a walk and be judged on the rail as a group at the walk both directions of the ring. Riders are to be judged on form, presentation, and style. Trainers may help with diagonals. The class will line up. Each rider and handler will individually trot down one long rail, reverse and trot back, and return to the lineup. Trainers may designate a temporary header in the lineup show so that he/she may run with their different riders.

SHOW SCHEDULE
